

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS and RESPONSE SERVICES

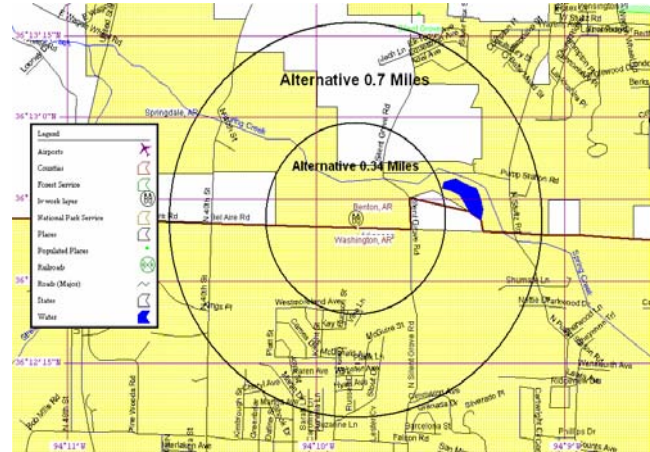

Our services include preparation of comprehensive Release Prevention and Emergency Action Plans required by EPA, OSHA, DOT and other regulatory agencies. Specific services include: preparation of SPCC Plans; RCRA Contingency Plans; Air Pollution Prevention Plans; OSHA Emergency Action Plans for Fire Prevention, Evacuation, Process Safety Management and Hazwoper; and Risk Management Plans. Also, development of hazardous material computer database systems to track materials for compliance with SARA Title III requirements, and preparation of annual Tier II/Toxic Release Inventory reports.

Experience and Capabilities

- Developed an emergency response training and procedures program at a major industrial facility. Services included training and planning for medical emergencies, fires, chemical spills, (i.e., flammable liquids, sodium hydroxide, hydrochloric acid, sulfuric acid, etc.), gas releases (i.e., natural gas, chlorine, etc.), asbestos abatement, rescue, and incident command.
- Prepared Air Pollution Prevention Plans for industrial facilities including: conveyor and material handling products and box plant.
- Prepared Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures Plans for industrial facilities that store and/or use oil and petroleum products.
- Prepared Release Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plans for a major industrial company with multiple locations throughout the U.S. and neighboring countries. This plan is comparable to the "One Plan" format developed by the multi-agency National Response Team.
- Developed Risk Management Programs for industrial/municipal facilities including: specialty chemical, natural gas processing, pesticide production, water treatment plants and pulp and paper manufacturing.
- Developed Process Safety Management Plans for natural gas processing and chemical manufacturing facilities.
- Prepared OSHA Emergency Action Plans and Hazwoper Contingency Plans for a wide variety of manufacturing facilities and hazardous waste operations.
- Conducted facility-wide hazardous chemical inventories for facilities subject to SARA Title III regulations, including two large chemical refineries (Arkansas and Texas), a paper mill and associated bag plant, a furniture manufacturer, and fertilizer manufacturer.

- Development and implementation of computer database systems to manage SARA Title III related data.
- Conducted SARA Title III regulation seminars for managers of industrial facilities in Arkansas.
- Reviewed existing SARA Title III compliance system and reports for industrial facilities located in Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Texas, and Florida. Recommended system changes as needed to address deficiencies and developed QA/QC procedures to ensure compliance.
- Prepared SARA Title III reports including Section 302/303 notifications, Section 311/312 (Tier 1/II) inventory reports and Section 313 toxic chemical release reports (Form R) and accompanying documentation for industrial facilities located in Arkansas, Louisiana, Florida and Texas.
